



- **Facilitate** the discussions during the 2SCM
- Prepare final Action Group report and contribute to the **synthesis documents** post-Forum



- **Assigned** to each Action Group
- **Follows** the work of the Action Group and **communicate** regularly with it
- **Gives** indications and **supports** the Group
- **Report** to the Pilot Group about the progress of work

Who - Broader community of practice – formed through and open call

What - Influence the content development with a bottom-up contribution and successful examples

Where - Aligned with each Action Group

How -

1. Solicited to react to and comment on different proposals
2. Contribute to the identified activities
3. Respond to surveys; etc.

- Participate at priority or action level
- Support specific activities through their commitment

- By mid-July → **identification of concrete actions** (e.g. 3) and **roadmap** for meetings
- 2nd Stakeholder Consultation Meeting (2nd SCM) → submission to the Pilot Group of the **anticipated action outcomes** and identification of number of sessions at the Forum + Dakar 2021 Initiative Project submissions
- By September → submission of general **session requests** to Pilot Groups for review
- By October → submission to the Pilot group of **full session proposals** from session groups
- By December → **final session proposals** confirmed
- At the Forum → submission of **session reports** and synthesis of the **outcomes /main messages**
